Eight schools from the southern region will compete against eight schools from the northern region in four different pools. Due to the fact that every team plays for a position to the last match, means that every team will compete in six matches over the weekend. This will not only create an excellent opportunity for players in

the T20 format, but also serves as proper pre-season matches for most teams. Especially during the Covid-19 pandemic, so much was taken away from the players, but here we strive to give as much as possible.

Grey College Secondary



Grey College was founded on 13 October 1855 when Sir George Grey paid a visit to the Orange Free State Republic and donated a sum of money towards the establishment of an institute for higher education.

The school was officially opened on 17 January 1859 and is the third-oldest school in South Africa and the oldest North of the Orange River. Afrikaans and English-speaking pupils study under one roof, but each language group is educated in separate classrooms and in its own mother tongue. The school grounds consist of a number of historic buildings, of which five are Free State provincial heritage sites: the Main building and Hamilton Hall, the Andrew Murray House, the Brill House and the Tuck shop.

Sport has always been a huge part of the Grey College culture and the school has some of the best sports facilities in South Africa. On the cricket side there are 8 cricket ovals on campus, a turf net complex consisting of 18 turf strips, an artificial net complex with 21 nets and a brand-new state of the art indoor cricket centre. The indoor centre has 7 lanes, an activation gym, team analysis room and an eye training facility.

We are also very proud of the fact that, since re-admission into international sport, Grey College has produced the most One Day International players and the second most Test cricketers for South Africa.

Hoërskool Centurion is reeds deur twee gedwonge naamsveranderinge. Die skool het as die Lytteltonse Hoërskool in 1959 begin, aangesien dit in die hartjie van Lyttelton geleë is. Daarna het dit sedert die 1970's as Hoërskool Verwoerdburg in die Verwoerdburg-area bekendgestaan. Met die naamsverandering van die stad na Centurion (vernoem na die bekende krieketstadion), het die skool ook hul naam verander in 1997.

Hoërskool Centurion is 'n trotse krieketskool, wat hulself die laaste 25 jaar bewys het as een van die toonaangewende krieketskole in die land. Dit reflekteer dan ook waarom die skool in albei finale van die eerste twee Noord-Suid T20 toernooie gespeel het en die huidige kampioene is. Die skool het boonop in die laaste 15 jaar drie keer die Gunn & Moore Noordvaal gewen en ook vier keer as naasweners uit die stryd getree.

Centurion, wat 64 jaar oud is, was een van die stigterslede van die Finsbury Superliga wat gedurende die eerste kwartaal deur die noordelike skole in die land gespeel word en was reeds sewe keer as weners gekroon. In 2017 was Centurion boonop die plaatweners van die K.S.A. Skole T20-kompetisie.

Buiten die talle provinsiale spelers wat deur die skool opgelewer is, is Duanne Olivier en Shaun von Berg die mees onlangse presteerders op nasionale vlak. Die Protea dames span se kaptein, Dané van Niekerk, is ook 'n produk van die skool, waarop ons tans baie trots is.

Important Playing Conditions

1. Playing Times: Morning matches: 9:00 – 12:00 | Afternoon matches: 14:00 – 17:00.
2. Extra Time available before losing overs: 30 minutes.
3. Minimum of 5 overs will constitute a match.
4. White IXU four-piece balls will be used and black sight screens will be in place.
5. In the case of any tied matches, a Super Over will be played to determine a winner.
6. The Super Over will start within 5 minutes after the completion of the match, with the team that batted last, who will bat first during the super over. The Super Over's playing conditions are attached to the full set of playing conditions distributed to all teams and umpires.
7. During the first six overs only two fielders will be allowed outside the 27.5m circle. Thereafter not more than 5 fielders will be allowed outside the circle.
8. Point allocation will be as follows:

Win with bonus point	5 points
Win without bonus point	4 points
Tied match (No Super over)	3 points
Matches with no Result	2 points
Lost matches	0 points
9. Net Run Rate will be calculated after every match in case it might be determined which team might get through to the higher play-off position.
10. The SA schools Code of Conduct will be strictly applied and any possible disciplinary hearings will be dealt with the same evening.
11. The prize money of R100 000 will be distributed as follows:

Winners	R50 000
Runners-up	R25 000
Third place	R15 000
Plate final winners	R 7 000 (9th position)
Plate final runner-up	R 3 000 (10th position)

In case the quarter finals get rained out, the team that ended higher in the pool matches, will proceed to the semi-finals. In case the semi-finals get rained out, the winner will be determined firstly by the team with the greatest number of wins in this year's tournament. After that the most bonus points will be taken in consideration, whereafter the Net Run Rate will be the last point to determine the teams to qualify for the final. In case the final is rained out and a winner can't be determined, the prize money will be shared between both teams. In the case that all the matches from quarter finals onward get rained out, the prize money will not be shared, but will be carried over to next year's tournament.

Met twee Parkies as kapteine van die Protea mans en vroue T20-span (Heinrich Klaasen en Suné Luus) bewys dit die passie en fokus op die Menlo-filosofie.

Menlo het die nasionale T20-kompetisie in 2010 en 2015 gewen, asook die eerste Noord-Suid T20-kompetisie in 2018. Menlo het ook in die finaal van die 2019 Noord-Suid gespeel.

The South African College School (SACS)



The concept of the South African College was first formed in 1791 when the Dutch Commissioner-General, Jacob Abraham Uitenhage de Mist, asked for funding to be set aside to improve schooling in the Cape. After the British took over control of the Cape Colony the second colonial governor, Lord Charles Henry Somerset PC, gave permission for the funds reserved by de Mist to be used to establish the South African College in 1814.

The founding committee met in the Groote Kerk to discuss funding and accommodation for the school and on 1 October 1829, the inauguration of the South African College was held and classes began. The original location of the school was in the Weeshuis on Long Street and moved to what is now known as the Egyptian Building in the Gardens district of Cape Town in 1841.

It was decided in 1874 that the younger students should be separated from their older counterparts. The South African College was separated into the College which became the University of Cape Town and the College School.

The College School (SACS) moved to its own building on Orange Street, separate from the College, in 1896. For the next few decades, the school grew and the building became too small for the number of students attending.

In 1959 the school moved to its current home in the Montebello Estate in Newlands, former home of the mining magnate Sir Max Michaelis, after a decade-long negotiation with the Cape Administration.

Rhodes Scholarship

When Cecil John Rhodes died in 1902, he specifically named the South African College in his will as one of four schools in the Cape Colony where the Rhodes Scholarship would be awarded on an annual basis for a former student to study at the University of Oxford.

St Andrew's College



ST ANDREW'S COLLEGE

The game of cricket has been played at College from the early 1860s and many Andrean cricketers have been selected for Eastern Province Nuffield / CSA Cricket Week teams and South African Schools sides. A creditable band has gone on to play provincial cricket.

Among these splendid players, Arthur Short went on to be selected for the Springbok side in 1970. Rupert 'Spook' Hanley's was selected to the unofficial test side in 1974-1976 seasons.

Throughout the years St Andrew cricketers have enjoyed super coaching both from masters and from early professionals. St Andrew's cricket has been particularly associated with Ash Brooker, for a short time with Roy Gathorne, and, between 1972 and 1990, with Harry Birrell (OA).

The first-ever cricket tour to England was undertaken in 1973 with Birrell and Paul Marsh as managers. Also on the tour was well-known umpire Peter Mansfield. The captain of this team – which included other such well-known Andreans as Nick Mallett, Antony Clark, Nicolas Pagden and Bob Whyte – was Robbie Armitage. Later, Armitage was selected for three unofficial one day internationals against the West Indies and, in 1982, was named 'Cricketer of the Year'.

John Stephenson also fulfilled all his early promises by playing for South African Universities, Eastern Province, the Defence Force and SA Country Districts.

In 1986 the OA Club celebrated its centenary, and a cricket festival was one of the celebrations. Sportsman Duf Rennie (1959), a member of the unbeaten First XV, was instrumental in inviting the illustrious Wilf Isaacs XI to a game against an OA side. The visiting team included Graeme Pollock as captain and five Springbok players. The OAs were captained by Peter van der Merwe and included Springboks Arthur Short and Robbie Armitage.

Recently College have continued celebrating cricket through numerous festivals and cricket weeks. The boys have enjoyed valuable exposure in the Grahamstown Schools' Festivals, Independent Schools' Festivals, St George's College (Harare) Tournaments, Michaelmas Weeks, Cape Schools' Weeks, Michaelhouse U17 Festivals, North South T20 Tournament, St David's Marist Inanda T20 Tournaments, Grey High School Festivals, Namibia Tour, KZN Tour, England Tours, Charl Van Rooyen Weeks, and Trinityhouse Festivals. The England Tours have created strong friendships with Wellington College and Malvern College, as a result we've enjoyed battles both on lower field and abroad.
